





I he push-back racking allows pallets of varying types and sizes to be stored together, two, three or even four deep, with quick and easy access. Pallets are loaded in sequence onto wheeled carriers or cradles of varying heights which are 'pushed back' on inclined steel channels to utilize the full depth of the racking. All pallets loading on every level are readily available at the face of the rack. This type of racking is well suited to the task of bulk storage and bulk handling without first-in-first-out access.



Mezzanine Racking System


